Director General Message

Thank You. Helping Mike and Judie plan and implement Tehran's 2012 year has been a satisfying experience. They are special people - hard working, giving, and fun. All events Chairmen did very well. Special thanks to Denise, events planner extraordinaire and de facto publisher of the Monthly Scroll, for her attention to detail and commitment to excellence.

Membership. My plan is to recruit Shriners who are active in their Blue Lodges to be our ambassadors to recruit new members. Feedback from Divan members and about 3 dozen potential ambassadors was excellent. Reaction from other Masons Mike and I spoke to was excellent. I prepared "kits" (folders containing Masonic, Scottish Rite, Hospital, Shrine applications and information, and a sheet containing a concise explanation of what to do with these materials and talking points were included. We passed them out to about 3 dozen potential ambassadors. What happened? Very little. Some feedback indicated that they didn't know what to do. My theory is that 2 things happened. First, they didn't really look at the materials and figure out what to do and, second, I suspect that those who did consider standing up in their Blue Lodges to speak about Shrine imagined other members staring at them wondering what the heck they were doing talking about Shrine in the Blue Lodge and felt especially uncomfortable since that would be stepping "outside of the box" and taking the risk their effort would be disapproved of and their standing in the Lodge might be diminished. With those thoughts in mind I considered what I would have to do to try to overcome the problem: go to a whole bunch of lodge meetings to try to show them the speech to give, and engage in many one on one talks, meetings and phone calls every week to try to push it along. I just did not and do not have the energy to do this. I do apologize but just don't have it in me. If there is a group of, say, 5 men willing to do this, I'd love to help them.

Shriners Hospitals for Children Northern California (SHCNC) -SCREENING CLINICS update:

On November 2, 2012, I participated in a phone conference organized by Imperial Hospital Trustee Skp Stanaway which included the Revenue Cycle Subcommittee and headquarters (Tampa) hospital staff, 6 or 7 Nobles and staff affiliated with the Salt Lake City Hospital. Lou Wentworth (Vice-Chairman, SHCNC) and myself were the only participants affiliated with SHCNC.

Topic of the conference was the replacement of the hospital applications forms we have been using at Screening Clinics with new "Cards". These cards provide the name, address, and phone number (applications office) for the hospital and leave a blank for the referring Shriner to enter his name (to get credit). The idea is that the child's parent or guardian will call the hospital. Reasons given for the decision to eliminate our old application forms are to: (1) avoid violating HIPPA; (2) avoid insurers questions as to why we have those forms; and (3) to get in line with standard practices in the industry.

But, very interestingly, patient application forms may not be dead after all just changed. Headquarters right now is working on new forms that will not run afoul of Hippa.

The Salt Lake people made effective statements concerning the potential adverse impact on the attitudes of Shriners actively involved in screening clinics and doubts about the effectiveness of relying on patient family members to make calls to hospitals to arrange for treatment.

A headquarters person said that the parent/guardian is to fill out the new forms and to mail the new forms/cards to the hospital. A Salt Lake city person made a strong case for the screening role of trained Shriners and asked if we could assist in the filling out of the new forms. The Tampa people (I think) agreed we could assist them. I then commented that in order to maximize the percentage of the children approved who actually contact the hospital we should make it as "turnkey" for them as possible. I asked if there would be a problem if we bring stamped envelopes preaddressed to the hospital and then ask the parent/guardian if they would like for us to put the (new) form into the envelope, seal it and drop it in the mail for them. A male voice from Tampa

said, that's why we have these calls - that's a good solution.

It was asked if we could keep contact (not medical) information on the patients so we could stay involved to give them support. I don't think they answered that one but no one asserted that would violate HIPPA (it's just phone book information).

My understanding of what we can do is as follows:

- Conduct Screening clinics as we do now, but -
- Assist the parent/guardian with filling out the (new) form (they fill it out; we do not)
- Ask the parent/guardian if they would like for us to put the form in the preaddressed, stamped envelope and to drop it in the mailbox for them.
- Give the parent/guardian the new card with the hospital (admission dept) phone number, address and referring Noble and Temple, so they have the ability to independently call the hospital admission office.


