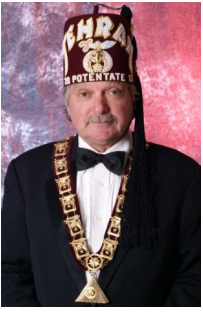

DIRECTOR GENERAL'S MESSAGE

What is Tehran's Most Urgent Need?

In the January and March Monthly Scrolls, the DG messages concerned our most important need - membership. But, that is not our most urgent need. Leadership is. If our membership recruitment plan is successful, we ought to have a pool of leaders to choose from in about 7 years. But, what about the next 6 years? We should have 7 officers in our Progressive Divan. We have 5. We need 4 good men to step forward and serve in 2013: 2 Ceremonial Masters, an Oriental Guide and a High Priest and Prophet (so I do not have to do it twice). These men must be committed to go all the way through the offices and serve as Potentate. Who will step forward and serve? What does it cost in time and money if one starts at the bottom?

Some say you must be prepared to attend all Tehran Shrine and Unit and Club events, all Western Shrine Association annual gatherings, all Shrine International annual meetings, Oriental Guide School, Assistant Rabban School, several Mass Installation or Balls at other Shrine Centers for all 7 Years. No one does all that. So what does one have to do? My approach when Charles Stirling III, PP, appointed me to the line beginning 2002 was to pace myself. The first 4 years one should participate in many local Shrine events and pick and chose what else should be attended and watch carefully what it takes to put on events. Attending other Shrine Center events is enriching and fun but does not do much for your reputation at home. The last 3 years one should participate heavily in local Shrine events and build relationships with those who are responsible and capable of chairing events. There are also Divan meetings and the time it takes to plan. Altogether, a big time commitment but spread over 7 years it is definitely part time.

Now, the money. What is discretionary and what is mandatory? Mandatory is attending and paying the charge for many local events: Shrine dinners and parties, Unit and Club dinners and parties, at least 3 WSA 3 day annual meetings; at least 2 Shrine International annual meetings, and the OG and AR Schools in Tampa. Most of the local events cost \$15 or less per person, with the formal events costing more. Remember that if you did not attend these events you would still have to pay for meals and having some entertainment. As to WSA, most of us take some vacation time and this year at Reno the cost is \$30 per room (\$15 each for double occupancy). WSA might be cheaper than the vacation you otherwise might take. The cost for the Imperial Sessions is substantially subsidized for our 2 elected representatives as is the travel cost for the Schools. Some well heeled Potentates have distributed gifts as a thank you to those who help and have hosted out of their own pockets very nice dinners. That's nice but unnecessary. Tehran's budget should cover modest gifts a Potentate is expected to present. Other than the schools, Tehran should not pay for anyone's expenses. All Divan members should pay their own expenses and no Divan member (including the Potentate) should pay for anyone else's personal expenses.

Never let it be said that a potential leader for Tehran Shrine during these next 7 crucial years is hiding under the table because he has been told it would cost him \$100,000 to be Potentate. That is not required. If you step forward your reputation as Potentate will be determined by the quality of your leadership not the depth of your pocket. Remember, the cost is the difference between what you spend on Shrine activities and what you would have spent doing something else and that is not much.

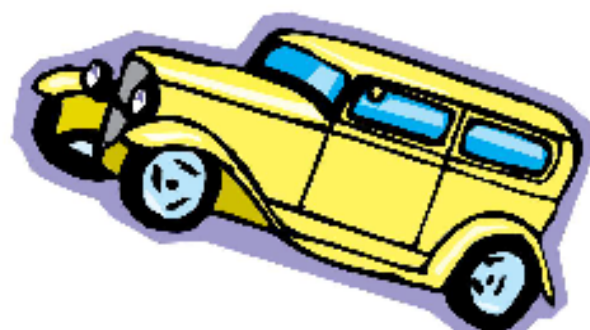

United Airlines Charity Miles Redemption Process for Temples

We are pleased to announce that Shriners Hospitals for Children® placed first in the United Airlines 10 Million Charity Miles Giveaway in December 2011. Our Shriners, staff and friends on Facebook and Twitter showed overwhelming support for our organization. Shriners Hospitals for Children garnered 32 percent of the votes among more than 45 worthy charities.

In order to be good stewards of this gift and maintain our partnership with United Airlines, the following guidelines for redeeming the miles must be followed. Miles can only be requested by temples on behalf of our patients and their families.

Travel arrangements should be made only when an appointment is confirmed with the hospital and traveling family members. The family, with the representative from the temple or hospital, should view the United Airlines flight schedule at www.united.com and find departure and return dates and times. This should be done no less than two weeks prior to the travel date and no more than 30 days prior to the travel date.

REQUESTING AIRLINE MILES

Once a date/time as been selected, the temple representative should call Ruby Valdes at 813-281-8110 with this information to book the flights. Please be sure to have the following information ready:

1. Complete full name and date of birth for the patient and traveling family member
2. A charge of \$5.00 to \$7.50 per person, per flight segment is the responsibility of the temple and must be paid by credit card at the time of booking the flight.
3. A telephone number and e-mail address for the traveling family member in case of airline changes in flight, times or cancellation of the flight by the airline.

Once complete, a confirmation number and flight itinerary will be sent to the temple and family. If for some reason the flight is cancelled, the temple must immediately contact Ruby Valdes at 813-281-8110. Ruby will document the cancellation — and the reason for cancellation — for our records and report it to the Chairman of the Board of Trustees.

The traveling family members should arrive at the airport at least one hour prior to the flight's departure. Allow extra time for parking, check-in and airport security screenings. Failure to check-in at least 10 minutes prior to departure could result in the family being bumped from the flight by the airline and loss of airline miles and any fees paid by the temple.

This letter is intended to inform you of the February 27, 2012 meeting of the Special Transportation Fund Sub-committee. Many of you received a letter dated February 6, 2012 explaining what the sub-committee was attempting to accomplish relative to establishing a Special SHCNC Transportation Fund to supplement transportation funds at Temples which have been experiencing financial difficulty transporting patients to SHCNC.

Temple Transportation Representatives of five of the six affiliated temples, plus Sabbar and Al Bahr temples, were present at the February 27 meeting; however, not all had the opportunity to discuss this issue with their Potentate and/or Divan. Those present agreed to continue the effort to establish this Special fund. Therefore, final approval of this Special fund by the sub-committee was delayed until the next regularly scheduled Board of Governors meeting on March 19, 2012.

It is important to remember this proposed fund is NOT an emergency fund, which it was referred to numerous times during the February 27 meeting. It is a fund, proposed to supplement, when needed and approved by hospital administration, the transportation funds for particularly both Sabbar and Al Bahr Temple patients. To restate, corporate headquarters provides funding to move patients on an emergency basis.

Basically, the sub-committee decided to recommend the establishment of a SHCNC Special Transportation Fund to supplement, under certain conditions and approvals, the transportation funds of Sabbar and Al Bahr Temples. The fund would be set up with twice annual voluntary donations of each affiliated temple, to this Special fund. It was agreed the suggested amount of the donation will be \$1.00 per Temple member, twice annually. It was suggested the Temple membership numbers for December 31, 2011 and June 30, 2012 be used for this purpose. The checks would be sent biannually by July 31 and January 31 each year made out to SHCNC with a memo note to "SHCNC Special Transportation Fund". The checks will be deposited with the Financial Services Division at SHCNC and used, when necessary, at the direction of SHCNC administration. Each Temple and the Board of Governors would be furnished with quarterly statements regarding fund revenues and expenditures commencing September 30, 2012.

It is important to remember the Board of Governors has no authority to require any Temple to participate in this effort. This is an appeal to SHCNC affiliated Temples to voluntarily assist Temples experiencing difficulty getting patients to SHCNC for medically necessary follow-up surgeries. This is NOT an emergency transportation fund; it is intended as a voluntary supplemental fund.

As stated previously, those attending the February 27 meeting have approved this concept. However, not all Temples were prepared to add their formal approval, as they didn't have ample opportunity to discuss this issue. The sub-committee is hopeful all will have had time to discuss this matter prior to the next scheduled BOG meeting on March 19 that the concept meets with your full approval, and we can move ahead with implementation.

In closing, we are extremely pleased to report that Tehran Temple already has made their 2012 donation equal to double their membership! Thank you, Tehran.

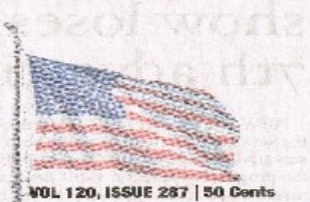

Kids get free medical screenings; some referred to Shriners hospital

Children afflicted with orthopedic conditions or burns received free medical screenings and some were referred to Shriners Hospital for Children in Sacramento to be treated.

The Sacramento location is one of two Shriners hospitals in the state and 22 in Canada, the U.S. and Mexico.

Patients are treated for burns and orthopedic conditions without regard of the patient's ability to pay, according to the hospital's website. To be treated, however, patients must be referred

and sponsored by a Shriners chapter, said Michael Nella, the potentate of Tehran Shriners in Fresno.

Shriners chapters raise funds throughout the year to pay for medical services in the hospital.

"If a child displays a medical problem of orthopedics or a burn then they're referred up to the hospital for acceptance," said Nella.

Eight Shriners volunteered at the free screenings in the Rehabilitation Center at Madera Community Hospital on Saturday.

Patients were served cookies and

punch as they waited to be called by Dr. Afshar Naz, who donated his time and care.

"The Shriners serve our community every year by helping children, and some are patients that cannot get help anywhere else," said Naz. "They help them get free state-of-the-art care at Shriners Hospital in Sacramento. So they get a free consultation here and, if it's needed, they are sent to Sacramento to get free care, something they would not be able to get otherwise. So I think it's a great service to our community."

Eight children were screened and six were referred to the hospital.

Nella was pleased with the turnout to the 11th annual free screening.

"It's one of the highest volume of turnouts we've

had in the last couple of years," he said.
