FROM THE ASSISTANT RABBAN

February and March continue to be very busy. Pam and I just returned from the Assistant Rabbans training in Tampa and are trying to catch up on our work. The training was informative, inspiring and very scary because it highlighted what we need to do now to save and grow Tehran. It was pointed out that a Shrine Temple is a group of dedicated Masons (and their wives) with like values that come together to interact with each other for a common purpose. Our common purpose is fellowship and the children whose lives we improve through our hospitals. A Shrine Center is only the building which offers us a place to come together. What I see at Tehran is that we need to keep our Temple strong by interacting with each other to continue to help the children and keep our Shrine Center strong and fun.

The last day of the training, Isabella Rose spoke to us about her Shrine Hospital experience. Isabella is now 15 years old and from the time she was born her mother knew she had a problem. When she would eat the food would come out of her nose and she had trouble breathing when she would lie down. She saw many doctors and they did not see the problem and told her mother "she would grow out of it." As time went on she started talking but could not pronounce certain words and other children would make fun of her so she stopped talking. When she was 5 years old a friend, who was a Shriner, suggested she be seen at our Chicago Shriners Hospital. Finally after they could get her to talk, the doctor recognized what was wrong and fixed it. She was born with a muscular cleft palate which looked normal when visualized but would not function properly. So after surgery and speech therapy she has grown to be a delightful, articulate and beautiful young lady. At the end of the meeting she sang for us a cappella and then had to leave for an acting audition. Each of you can be proud that through your membership in the Shrine, you have made another life better.

Although our Sacramento hospital stays very busy many of our hospitals are not, and the cost of our system continues to grow. The Imperial Hospital Board is looking into ways to see more kids. more efficiently and at a better cost and will be proposing changes at the Imperial Session this year. Our biggest need at Tehran, and all through the Shrine, remains membership. The Imperial Potentate is concentrating on membership and has set up goals and programs to help make it easier to refer a good Mason. Our Potentate has not only embraced the program but has many good plans to make it even better, but he continues to need the help of all of our members. 

Burn Prevention Education

allows Shriners Hospitals for Children — Northern California to extend its life-saving care beyond hospital walls. According to the American Burn Association (ABA), burns are one of the leading causes of unintentional injury and death in the United States.

Statistics compiled by the ABA show that:

- One civilian fire injury occurs every minute;
- 73 percent of the burn injuries treated in burn centers occur in the home;
- almost one-quarter (24%) of all burn injuries occur in children under the age of 15;
- The survival rate of those treated in burn centers is 96.7%.

Safety Begins at Home is the title of the Northern California hospital's burn prevention program targeted to children in grades K–3. Prevention mascots Ben & Ali bring safety messages to life as they guide children through an interactive presentation. Kids learn how to prevent burn injuries in all areas of the home – kitchen, bathroom, family room and outdoors. Local firefighters give kids a "tour" of a fire truck and reinforce the prevention message by teaching kids how to safely exit a house in case of fire. School children carry the message home to their families as each participant leaves with a prevention coloring book and information for parents.

While hundreds of children attend the program at the hospital in Sacramento each year, arrangements may be made to schedule the Safety Begins at Home program for a school assembly. It is just one more opportunity for children living in our communities to learn how to prevent scald burns, flame burns, electrical burns and more.
