Parade season is underway!

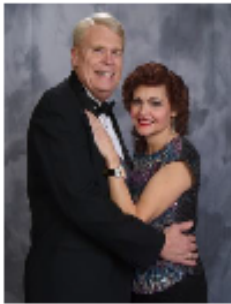

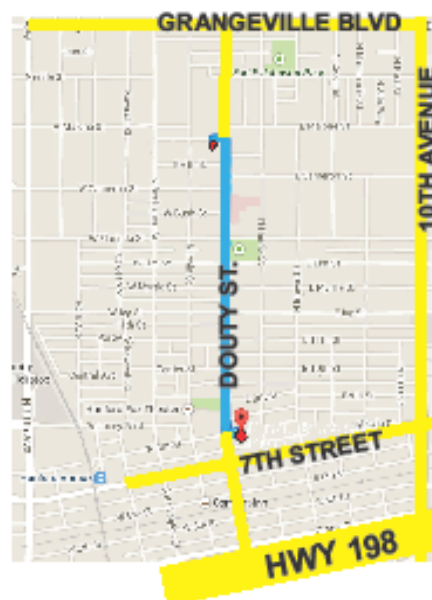
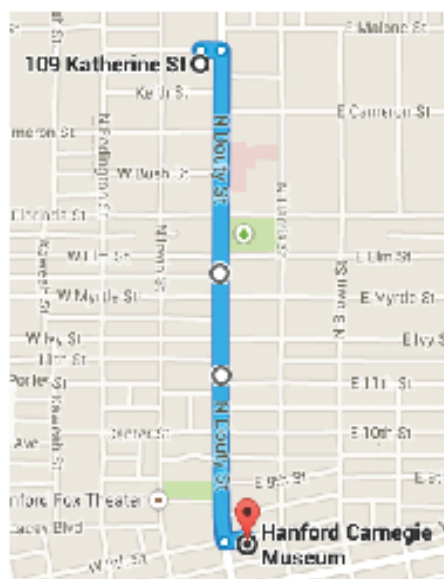
