SEPTEMBER Potentate's Message

Monday, August 21, was the Hospital Representatives Board of Governors meeting at Sacramento. Our own Ill. Sir David Johnson is Chairman of the Board this year and next. He did a wonderful job of keeping the meeting moving. Interestingly, the Sacramento Hospital has the most expensive salaries and equipment costs in our hospital system. It is 1.70 times more expensive to operate per patient treated than the average of all 22 hospitals! We also treat the most patients per year because of our multiple disciplines, including research!

Let me re-state Tehran's policy on the use of our newly re-furbished kitchen. Each Club or Unit wishing to use the kitchen should appoint a Noble who belongs to that Club or Unit to serve as their representative and be responsible to the Board of Directors regarding the proper use of the various components of the kitchen, their proper cleaning after use and the general cleaning of the hall after its use. Check lists have been created for this purpose and a form to request the use of the kitchen and hall has been formalized and approved by the Board. Any Club or Unit needs to submit the Request for Date Form to reserve the facility on a first-come first-served basis. I believe this scheduling will lead to a very practical way of insuring a calendared use of our facility.

Don't forget the Cambria Parade on Saturday, September 2. The Divan, Clowns and Flying Shriners will be there. Please join us!

Ladies, please make an effort to attend the First Lady Dale's luncheon on Saturday, September 9. Dale was very kind to give up the first scheduled date of Saturday, June 3, for the bus trip to the Hospital. Come hear her speak about her hospital project and the fun she has had this year as your First Lady!

FROM THE HIGH PRIEST AND PROPHET

As we approach the end of Summer, I hope everyone has had a wonderful one (I did but it was hot). I continue to be excited about what we do at our Shriner's hospitals. Our Sacramento hospital continues to be over budget, not because we don't do things well, but because we do them too well. The Shrine Hospital Board does not want any child that we can help turned away. Due to the low reimbursement rates from MEDICAL, other hospitals cannot afford to care for the complicated cases which we specialize in, so they send these kids to Shriner's. When you hear how wonderful our government insurance is, understand that the only way these children get quality care is through a charitable organization like the Shrine. At our last stated meeting we showed a film about the starting of our hospital system in 1922. At that time there was a polio epidemic and the Shriners stepped forward to provide care for the children with polio, and it has grown from there. We now maintain 22 hospital and last year took care of children from 168 countries around the world.

Last month I mentioned Walt and Madiline Kasabian who were important mentors in my Shrine careerer. There are many other people who influenced me, but this month I want to thank Past Potentate Ed Kerber and especially his wife Mary Jane. The Kerber's have always been there to offer help and support (although Ed was crotchety at times). Mary Jane had a rare talent and donated many of the beautiful faberge styled eggs she made to raise money for the hospital. Through her efforts we raised thousands of dollars and Pam still cherishes her music box and necklace.

As I sat up front during our Stated meeting listening to the lively discussion (reminded me of a junior high debating society) my mind drifted to the Charles Dickens play, a Christmas Carol. I thought of Scrooge, Tiny Tim and the Christmas Ghosts. When I thought of Christmas past I remembered my early Shrine experiences with the Pote's balls, shish-ka-bob, Nile luau, hospital screening clinics and of course the Clown BBQs. The many rehearsals with Jane Higgins choreographing and Ralph and Millie Takakjian doing "My Little Bumble Bee" and Denise Crossland singing "White Rabbit" it was a special time. The good old days made me feel warm and happy. I then I thought of Christmas present when Scrooge was so cold and devoid of charity, only thinking of himself, that he thought there should be more debtors prison for the needy. I looked at Tehran, where new members are not feeling the joy and involvement that blessed me. Then as Scrooge looked at Christmas future he saw how he was thought of as they stole and sold his curtains and bed clothes because he would no longer need them. Who is going to help our Tiny Tims when Tehran is not here to help and who will pick over our bones when Tehran is gone?

At our stated meeting a past potentate, (whom I like and greatly respect) cautioned me about the negativity in my articles. I tried to explain that the purpose of the articles was not to be negative but to offer a warning and hopefully enlist help. When a frog is put in a pan of warm water on the stove and the heat turned up, he will stay there until he dies unless there is something to alarm him. I have had many Shriners, and there wives, tell me how much they enjoy my articles, but I have had none come to me with ideas and the offer of help. Your Divan is dedicated to improving and saving Tehran, but it is the members who must make it happen. Communication is important to keep a organization vibrant, so the Potentate has suggested having Dinner with the Divan one Sunday afternoon each month, to share fellowship, hear your ideas and keep you informed of our progress. My project for 2017 is the purchase of a SARA COMBILIZER for the Northern California Shriners Hospital.

The Sara Combilizer is a patient mobilizer that will improve nursing and physical therapy's ability to mobilize critical care patients earlier, while ensuring optimal safety for both patient and staff. Safe Patient Handling and Early Mobilization are regulatory requirements. The usage of this equipment would assist in early ambulation for spinal fusions and critical burns over the age of six. Early mobilization decreases falls, delirium, pneumonia, ventilator days and hospital length of stay. Without the proper equipment to support the patient, staff is unable to safely support the patient during mobilization without risk for injuring both patient and staff member. The cost for this equipment is \$17,800. It is my hope, that together, we can make this a reality for the Northern California Shriners Hospital.
